Penrith Valley has a long history in providing quality educational services, led by the University of Western Sydney, Western Sydney Institute of TAFE and the Nepean Hospital. Penrith provides a complete range of schooling and vocational and other training services to promote life long learning and skills development to meet the needs of an evolving industry base.

Close to 100 child care centres across Penrith Valley provide a full range of children's services required by families. Penrith City Council operates 35 centres, vacation care programs and a mobile playvan. Penrith Valley has a spread of 77 Primary and Secondary schools in the region. Of these 26 are private and 51 are state schools.

Western Sydney Institute (WSI) is the fastest growing TAFE Institute in NSW and delivers more than 1,000 courses to over 43,000 students in Australia. Nepean College has two campuses: Penrith and Kingswood. Courses offered stem around growth areas in the local economy such as tourism and hospitality, retailing, media, health, personal and community services, finance and business.

The 158 hectare Penrith campus of the University of Western Sydney (UWS) has sites at Kingswood and Werrington and offers courses in contemporary arts, design, education, business, science, engineering, arts and humanities. Penrith is also home to state of the art teaching facilities such as the Astronomy Centre, which houses the largest campus telescope in Australia and the Mechatronics facility which provides training, education and research opportunities to engineering students.
